Photo Guidelines

Do...

- Take high-resolution photos. If using a phone camera, set it to HDR (highest resolution setting)

- Take a variety of shots—from up high, low to the ground, full project and closeup at various angles and different times of the day to capture your project at its very best
- Trim grass and landscaping and shut off irrigation the day prior to photographing
- Uncover pools, hot tubs, grills, etc.

- Show a hose, pool cleaning equipment or trash bins
- Forget to sweep/clean your project
